**WINTER PARKING**

NO PARKING WITHIN 10 FEET OF THE EDGE OF THE ROAD IS ALLOWED ON ANY CITY STREET BETWEEN THE HOURS OF MIDNIGHT AND 8:00 A.M. All vehicles, boats, campers, trailers, construction equipment, etc. must be removed from the city right-of-ways. Citations will be issued for those who are not in compliance. This winter parking regulation takes effect from **NOVEMBER 1, 2024 TO APRIL 30, 2025.**

**December 14, 2024 is National Wreaths Across America Day,** and Wellsville will join in with a short program at our cemetery beginning at 10:00 a.m. Placement of the Christmas wreaths on our veteran's graves will follow the program. Individuals and families are encouraged to attend and help with the placement of the wreaths. Parents, this is an excellent opportunity to teach your children respect and honor for those who have served our country. Light refreshments will be available.

Sponsoring a wreath costs just \$17. These wreaths are made of natural pine boughs. They are not small, cheap items, but decent-sized, high-quality wreaths that are handmade with love and long-lasting quality.
