March 2025**UTILITY BILLING UPDATES**

As you will notice, your utility bill for January reflects the water rate increase (Code Amendment 2024-02). This increase was approved after the public hearings held on June 5, July 3, and July 17, 2024 where the need for a new culinary well was discussed. Wellsville City conducted a Water Rate Study in May 2024 and it was determined that the current rates were inadequate to cover the costs of drilling a new well. Due to these capital needs, a 5-year water rate increase structure was adopted to cover these expenses. The water rate increases will be as follows:

This new well, located near 900 South 200 West, was drilled to a depth of 800' and is currently flow testing at 1200 gal/min. This new well will ensure adequate water supply for all Wellsville residents, in addition to correcting serious water pressure issues on the south end of Wellsville. A pump house and other infrastructure upgrades are yet to be completed but are also a part of this project. Copies of the Water Rate Study are available at the city office.

Please note: If you have your utility payment set up on autopay or through your bank, you will need to adjust your payment to reflect the correct payment amount.

WINTER PARKING

IT IS THAT TIME OF YEAR WHEN PARKING WITHIN 10 FEET OF THE EDGE OF THE ROAD IS PROHIBITED ON ANY CITY STREET BETWEEN THE HOURS OF MIDNIGHT AND 8:00 A.M. All vehicles, boats, campers, trailers, construction equipment, etc. must be removed from the city right-of-way. Citations will be issued for those who are not in compliance. This winter parking regulation takes effect from NOVEMBER 1, 2024 TO APRIL 30, 2025.

DOG LICENSING

ALL DOGS that reside in Wellsville City limits are REQUIRED to be licensed. Licensing can be taken care of by mail or at the city office (Court Window). To license your dog, you must provide proof of current rabies shot and proof of neutering/spaying if that applies to your dog. Payment can only be accepted by Check or Cash.

REMINDER: AFTER MARCH 31ST THE FEES \$\$\$ FOR LICENSING YOUR DOG WILL TRIPLE!

WINTER STORMWATER POLLUTION PREVENTION TIPS

Start shoveling early, the more snow you remove, the less salt and sand you'll need. Here are some do's and don'ts when shoveling or plowing snow: **DO** → Pile snow in locations with the most opportunity to infiltrate into the ground. Pile snow in areas where water does not pond. Clear away any snow that may have been thrown onto the storm drains.

DON'T → Do Not pile snow on top of storm drains or near water bodies and wetlands, onto rain gardens or bioretention areas.
