WATER RESTRICTIONS AND PRESSURE

Wellsville City Utilities is asking all of its customers who water their lawns with culinary water to do so on designated days of the week based on your house number beginning on June 1, 2024. It's simple to do. Check your house number, even or odd?

EVEN HOUSE NUMBERS....

If your house number ends in an even number, such as 532, 1298, 164, water only on Monday, Wednesday and Friday.

ODD HOUSE NUMBERS....

If your house number ends in an odd number, such as 127, 531, 1587, water on Tuesday, Thursday and Saturday.

WHAT ABOUT SUNDAY?

We all take a break by not watering on Sunday, but our yards will still receive enough water to keep them healthy and attractive. Typically, even in dry and hot conditions, it is not necessary to water every day.

By helping with watering on your designated watering day, we are hoping this will help improve the water pressure issues we are experiencing. Thank you for your cooperation in helping to conserve our water.
